Re: Cell Phone/Smart Watch Use and Possession

Ref: School Handbook and NM Senate Bill 11

To Tiger students and families

While parents may wish to send their children to school with a cell phone to facilitate communication between home and student during transit, cell phones must be powered off and placed in the child's backpack or cubby during the school day. At no time during the school day may students use their phones or smart watches. This includes during before and after school activities.

If parents need to contact their child during the school day they may leave a message with the front desk. Emergency situations and any change to the level of security postures will be communicated directly from the school via the OneCall system. The school is not responsible for cell phones or smart watches brought to campus and families are encouraged to develop a system for communicating with their child. Violations of this policy will result in the confiscation of the device and administration will follow the discipline matrix in the school handbook.
